## Items you CAN donate:

- Furniture
- Kitchen and household items
- Baby goods and toys
- Insulated windows/doors
- Hand and power tools
- Books CD's and DVD's
- Building materials
- Small appliances/electronics (in good working order)
- Bicycles
- Flatscreen TV's, newer laptops , & more...

*Please note: Items may only be dropped off during normal Thrift Shop hours or by appointment. Acceptance of items is also subject to availability of space in Thrift Shop.*

## Items we WILL NOT accept:

- Mattresses & box springs
- Single pane windows
- Non-insulated doors
- Rugs too large to roll & stand up
- Teflon coated cookware w/ scratches or any chipped dinner/glassware
- Clothing/fabric items (try All in One or Serendipity for these items).
- TV's, VCRs, computers, printers, keyboards, or accessories (Bring to Universal Waste Day at Transfer Station – 2<sup>nd</sup> Sat. each month)
- Hazardous Household Waste (Bring to MDI HS Sept. 24, 2011)
